Description

Non-patent literature (NPL) is an important category of prior art. In certain technical fields, for example those in standards-driven industries, no search is complete without it. However, unlike patent literature, NPL is often spread across numerous sources with no common classification schemes or retrieval tools.

This seminar series looks at various aspects of searching NPL.

The first seminar explores the basic concepts and covers common NPL search characteristics. It also includes a brief introduction to the main NPL databases and search tools.

The second seminar comprises two sessions. The first of these looks in more detail into standards, as well as some specific NPL databases and the different strategies you can use to search them. The second session dives into searching Asian NPL databases, in particular the principal NPL databases in China, Japan and the Republic of Korea.

Finally, a main-takeaway and wrap-up seminar allows participants to summarise the most valuable information and discuss particular cases or problems they face when searching NPL.
