








Prompt Granting of Rights

Fully adopted the **CPC** in January 2015 to improve efficiency


- ✓ Improving the patent search system
 - Launched Chinese-to-Korean machine translation
 - Developing a next generation search system



Revision of Patent Act



- Eased the requirements for filing documents
- Now possible to file English-language applications






Revision of Patent Act



 Allows amendments to translations based on the original specification



- Extended the period for submitting translations in PCT applications after request
- Eased requirements for the grace period
 - It is now possible to amend application before registration



Revision of Patent Act (Under Consideration)



- Reducing the period for requesting examination (5 years → 3 years)
 - Encourages applicants to establish their rights quickly

- Allowing patent examiners to re-examine an application if legitimate ground for rejection is found
- Introducing a program allowing members of the public to request the cancellation of a patent right
 - Increases public confidence in patent quality
