Joint Statement on IP5 Cooperation


① Common Recognition

2014


The IP5 Offices agreed to disseminate patent information in XML format,

Global Dossier Vision Statements

Alerting

Provide timely updates to users on status or file wrapper changes to all IP5 family members of an application being watched.

XML Based Documents

Maintain focus on increasing the provision by IP5 offices of all file wrapper documents in XML.

Applicant Name standardisation

Harmonise applicant names across IP5 patent document collections.

Legal Status

Agree on the sharing of legal status data for patents and applications across the IP5.

Proof of Concept: Applicant Initiated Inter-Office Document Exchange Demonstrate the feasibility of cross filing documents or changes over the entire IP5 using an example submission achievable in today's IP5 legal frameworks at each jurisdiction.
