


Legal Status



Constraints & Assumptions



Next Steps on Legal Status

- 2. Each office will provide feedback before April 30th, 2016.
- •4. After the Heads Meeting, the IP5 should design approach to implement data exchange.



- 1. By the end of March 2016 (DH Meeting), SIPO finalize the <u>questionnaire</u> including the <u>proposed common categories</u> on the legal status and circulate it.
- 3. SIPO will report the survey results and the common categories of legal status to the Heads of IP5 offices on June, 2016.
