 - 1. Reported the result of the each office's case studies and simple analysis on the studies
 - → More detailed analysis on the studies was suggested by the JPO.

2. Present Situation



- Detailed analysis on the case studies
 - JPO, KIPO and USPTO applied the same criteria to all of Cases 1-3. On the other hand, EPO and SIPO applied the criteria in accordance with each of the specific features of the Cases.
- Only as for Case Study 2, the results were different among the IP5 Offices.
 - EPO [No] applied the criteria for chemical compounds defined by measurable parameters.
 - SIPO [Yes/No] applied the specific criteria when the improvement of a claim compared to the background art involves a numerical range.
 - JPO [Yes/No] considered whether or not there is the common general technical knowledge.
