IP5 Global Dossier evolution

- IP5 Heads agreed June 2012 :
 - a framework for IT-related initiatives
 - a user-centric vision for the IP5 Cooperation
 - must include user input and representation
- IP5 Heads approved Mandate October 2012
 - participation of IP5 Offices, WIPO and representatives from each IP5 Industry region
 - Task Force (GDTF) to define business requirements
 - 1st Global Dossier Task Force meeting to be hosted by EPO in conjunction with next IP5 WG2 meeting, January 2013



IP5 Global Dossier Mandate

- Take note of both user and office requirements and priorities
- Identify stakeholders and the means for them to engage in process
- Analysis of current IT plans of each IP5 Office
 - What services are planned in Offices current renewal programmes
- Identify the business and IT changes required and align those changes with existing initiatives or create new services
 - Open services to the public using common standards
 - Consolidated file wrapper access (IP5 OPD)
- Consider legal aspects and further opportunities for business process re-engineering
- Establish the Global Dossier Roadmap



Global Dossier - Definitions

- Business Requirements and Priorities
 - EPO will propose template and initiate drafting of business requirements
 - Key business "blocks" and priorities to be defined
 - Input from Offices, WIPO and Industry before GDTF meeting
- Potential Global Dossier business "blocks"
 - Linking current re-engineering initiatives in IP5 Offices towards global sharing of and access to information
 - Cross Filing and Portfolio Management services
 - Work sharing opportunities between Offices
 - Real-time Collaboration services
 - examiner-applicant, examiner-examiner, and third-party
 - Machine Translation services
 - Support for Due Diligence for appeals, litigation etc.



1st IP5 Global Dossier Task Force meeting and alignment with IP5 Working Group 2

- EPO is hosting this first event in the Netherlands
 - 22-23 January 2012, The Hague
- Global Dossier Task Force will meet as part of the IP5 Working Group 2 Meeting
- First time that IP5 users are directly involved in the planning and development of services
- IP5 WG2 to prepare first IP5 Global Dossier Road Map taking into account the input from IP5 industry and users. Define implementation timetable and means based on needs and priorities
- IP5 Global Dossier Road Map to be endorsed by IP5 Heads
