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
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
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
## 1-1. Growing Demand for Harmonization & Work Sharing due to Globalization




#### **Upward trend in Overseas Filing in Japan**



### 1-2. Growing Demand for Harmonization & Work Sharing due to Globalization






Innovation is being developed in the world.
Globalization enhances needs for obtaining patens abroad.




Increase applications all over the world. Increase in duplicative applications.

- ➤ Different protection levels under different IP systems.
- → To increase predictability of patent obtainment abroad, International Harmonization of Patent System is essential.
- ➤ Inefficiency and unnecessary cost generated by duplicate examinations.
- → To reduce cost and improve efficiency, Work-Sharing is essential.

## 1-3. Growing Demand for Harmonization & Work Sharing due to Globalization





- >Globalization also enhances needs for obtaining patents not only Trilateral regions but also developing countries.
- > Rapid increase of patent filing in China and other developing countries.

A global framework and infrastructure for developing countries are also important for the Trilateral Offices.

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## 2-1. Harmonization of Substantive Patent Systems

- ➤ Since 2005, the First Package\*¹ has been discussed among developed countries. (B+ meeting)

  \* Novelty, Inventive Step, First-to-File & Grace Period, etc.
- At the B+ meeting, issues, such as First-to-File and Grace Period, are major topics to achieve international substantive patent law harmonization.

## Realization of harmonization is long-awaited and urged from political and business sectors.

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## 3-1. Work Sharing based on Information Sharing

#### **Priority Document Exchange**

#### **Application**

Priority Document Exchange (among Trilateral Offices, between JPO/KIPO)

Second Filing Office (OSF) receives the priority document issued by First Filing Office (OFF) electronically.

Digital Access Service of priority document (Under discussion for implementation at WIPO)

#### Dossier Access System

#### **Search Results**

- **EPO:** Prioritizes search for first filings.

## JPO: Prioritize First Action for first filings (planned).

#### **Final Examination Results**

➤ Patent Prosecution Highway (PPH)

The framework in which an application determined to be patentable in the OFF is eligible to have accelerated examination in the OSF by offering the examination results of the OFF.

- -JPO:USPTO(Jul. 2006), KIPO(Apr. 2007), UKIPO(Jul. 2007), GPTO (planned in Mar. 2008)
- -USPTO: UKIPO(Sep. 2007), KIPO (planned in 2008)

Grant

Each type of work sharing contributes to an increase in the efficiency of the patent examination of global applications.

## 3-2. Work Sharing Frameworks

Promote work-sharing with utilizing various resources — Search, First Action (FA), Decision to Grant

Improve work-sharing efficiency to the maximum extent by combining various resources while taking into account the institutional varieties among offices.

### 3-3. Mutual Utilization of FA Results


Utilizing FA results among offices will reduce workload and cost, improve patent quality, and expedite patent granting.

**Japan** Prioritize examination of first filing. (planned)



Improve efficiency and quality of patent.


**U.S.** SHARE Proposal (Strategic Handling of Applications for Rapid Examination)



### 3-4. Mutual Utilization of FA Results ~ New Route Proposal~

- First filing with OFF to be considered "simultaneous filing" with IP offices of other countries.

  Filing cost reduced.
- >Legal timeframe: OFF examines first. Then, OSF utilizes search and examination results of OFF.
- Duplication of search/examination avoided, and the applicant's procedural cost reduced.
- >Applicant defers submission of translation to OSF until exam results of OFF have been produced.
  - No unnecessary cost of translation.
- > In early 2008, an analogous pilot project is due to start between the JPO and the USPTO.




### 3-5. Mutual Utilization of Patent Decisions ~ Patent Prosecution Highway (PPH)~

If a patent application has been determined to be patentable in the OFF, the corresponding application is qualified for accelerated examination in the OSF. PCT applications are also eligible.


Quick patent obtainment abroad / Reduce workload in IP offices / Enhance examination quality

JPO-USPTO, UKIPO, KIPO: In Practice JPO-GPTO: Planned (March 2008) JPO plans to expand PPH with other offices.



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
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## 4-1. Information Network Supporting Work Sharing (PDX)




Conventional situation: An applicant must obtain a priority document from the OFF and submit it to the OSF.

### **Advantage of Priority Document Exchange**

- > Reduction of procedural/financial burdens of applicants
- Reduction of administrative burdens of patent offices
- > Easy to identify applications to overseas for OFF to prioritize examination, where requested priority documents from the OSF


### 4-2. Information Network Supporting Work Sharing

## 4-3. Common Application Format

- Standardizing Patent Application Format (incl. PCT)
- The applicants can reduce the burden for re-drafting according to different formats among the offices.



- The revision of PCT Administrative Instructions will be proposed at the earliest opportunity.
- Trilateral Offices will start operations when prepared.
   The JPO is aiming at starting operations in April, 2009.

### **Expectations to the Industry**

- ➤ Take an ambitious step forward to construct the global system.
- ➤ Seek the early realization of harmonization by supporting its positive progress through government-and-private cooperation.

- ▶Promote cooperation between Patent Offices and users that is essential for efficient Work Sharing.
- Examine measures in response to environmental change surrounding economical society. (e.g. open innovation.)
  - Open review will be introduced on a trial basis in Japan.
- > Recognize the importance of Trilateral Offices, together with WIPO.
