Plasmapp Co., Ltd., Korea – The role of a strong IPR portfolio in growing a medical device company and securing \$50 M funding Perspectives from Chief Strategy Officer and Chief Legal Officer Aiden Han

Plasmapp Co., Ltd. is an innovative manufacturing company specializing in plasma technologies originated at the Korea Advanced Institute of Science and Technology (KAIST). Based on this technology, Plasmapp has devised a novel plasma sterilizer STERLINK® for medical tools. This technology is made possible by STERPACK® packaging pouches, which feature a sterilization cycle time of only 5 minutes, and which allow sterilization to be completed at a low temperature of 55°C. Furthermore, plasma sterilization is free from toxic EO gas, making the process eco-friendly and harmless.

Plasmapp was founded in 2015 and has attracted \$50 M in funding since then. Plasmapp has submitted 128 patents in Asia, Europe and the USA, with 43 patents registered to date, and was commended by the Korean Ministry of Trade, Industry and Energy for Excellence in IP Management.

The case study will be presented by Aiden Han, former BCG consultant, Chief Strategy Officer and Chief Legal Officer of Plasmapp and a licensed attorney-at-law (NY & Korea)/patent attorney (Korea). We will discuss the role of the patent portfolio in securing growth funding and the planned IPO, in enabling a variety of business models and preparing for extension of the product portfolio of Plasmapp.

Aiden is a dual licensed Attorney-at-law (New York and Korea), and licensed patent attorney (Korea). He earned Juris Doctor from Yonsei University, and LL.M. from University of Washington (summa cum laude).

At Kim & Chang, a law firm in Korea, he worked on high-profile international commercial and sports arbitration cases including representation of Korean government in ICSID arbitration.
