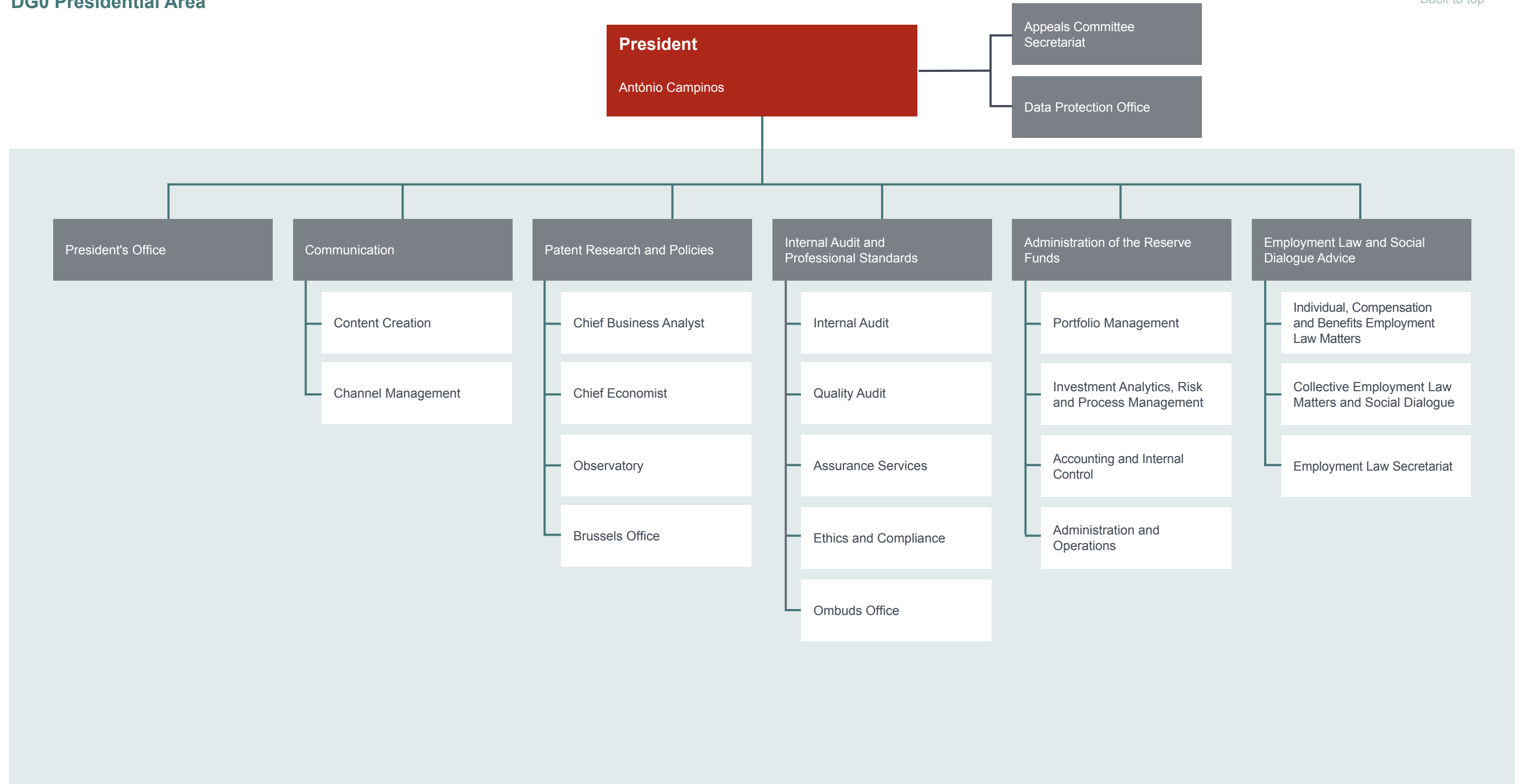

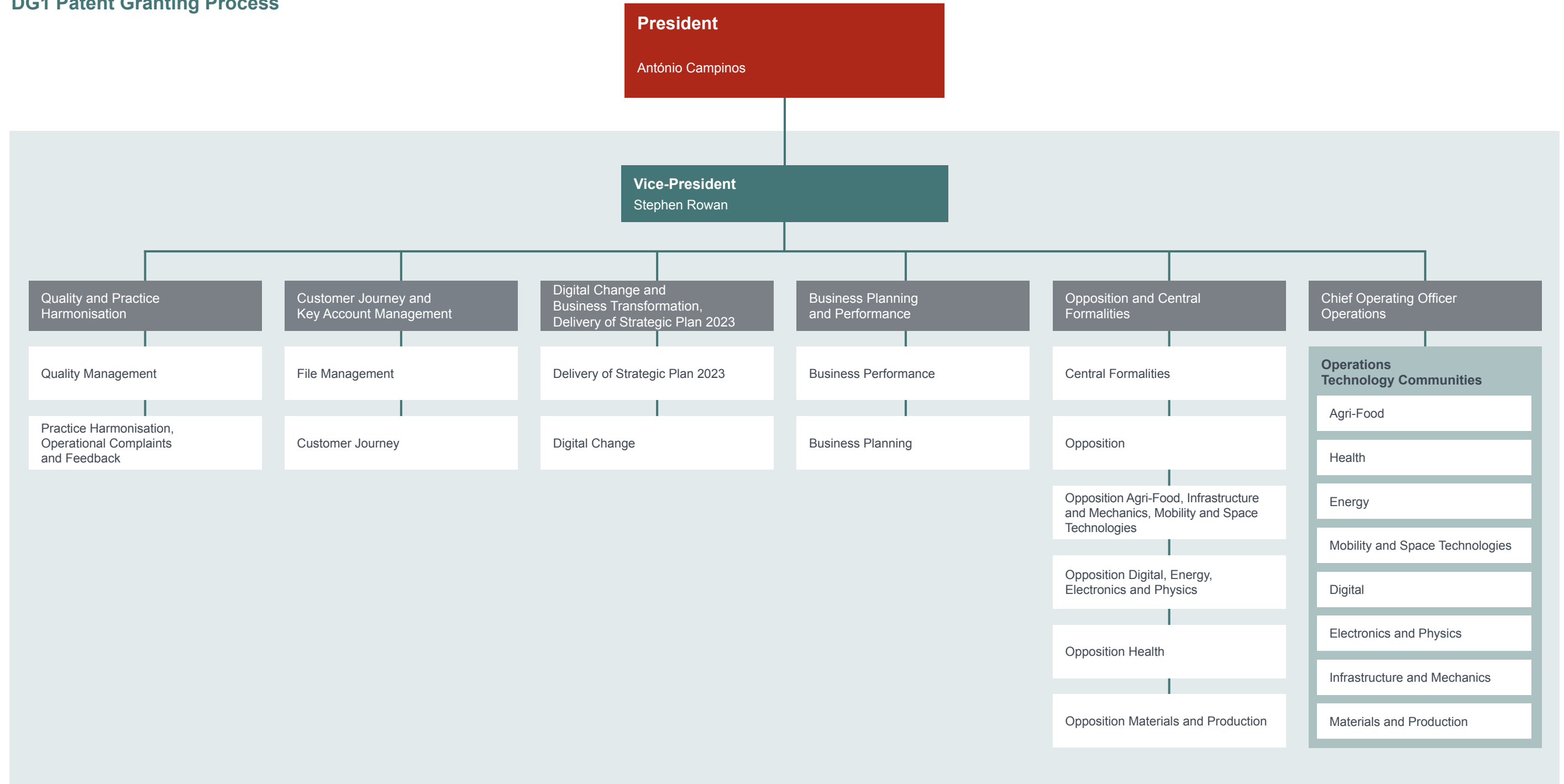


Structure of the European Patent Office

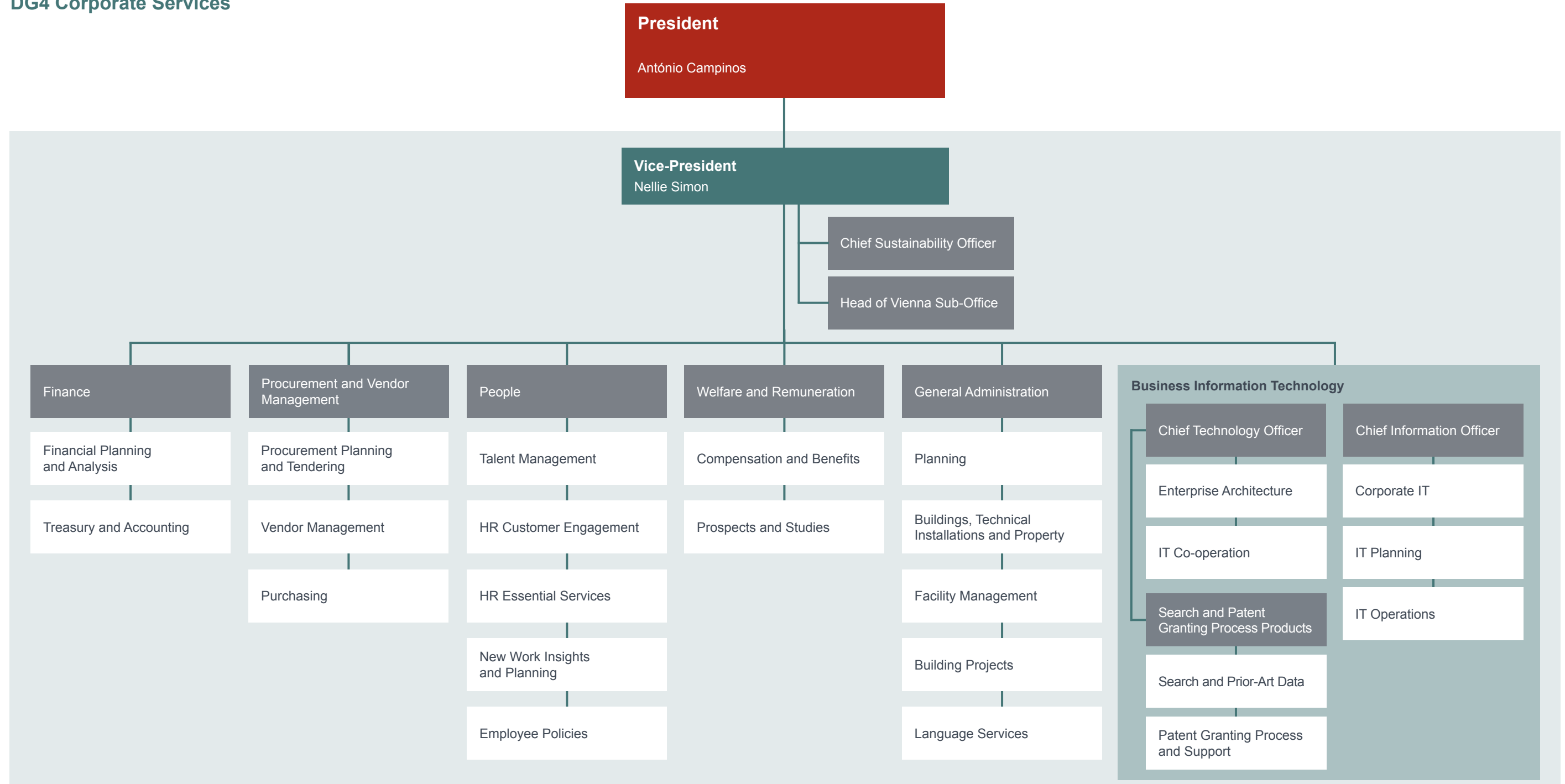

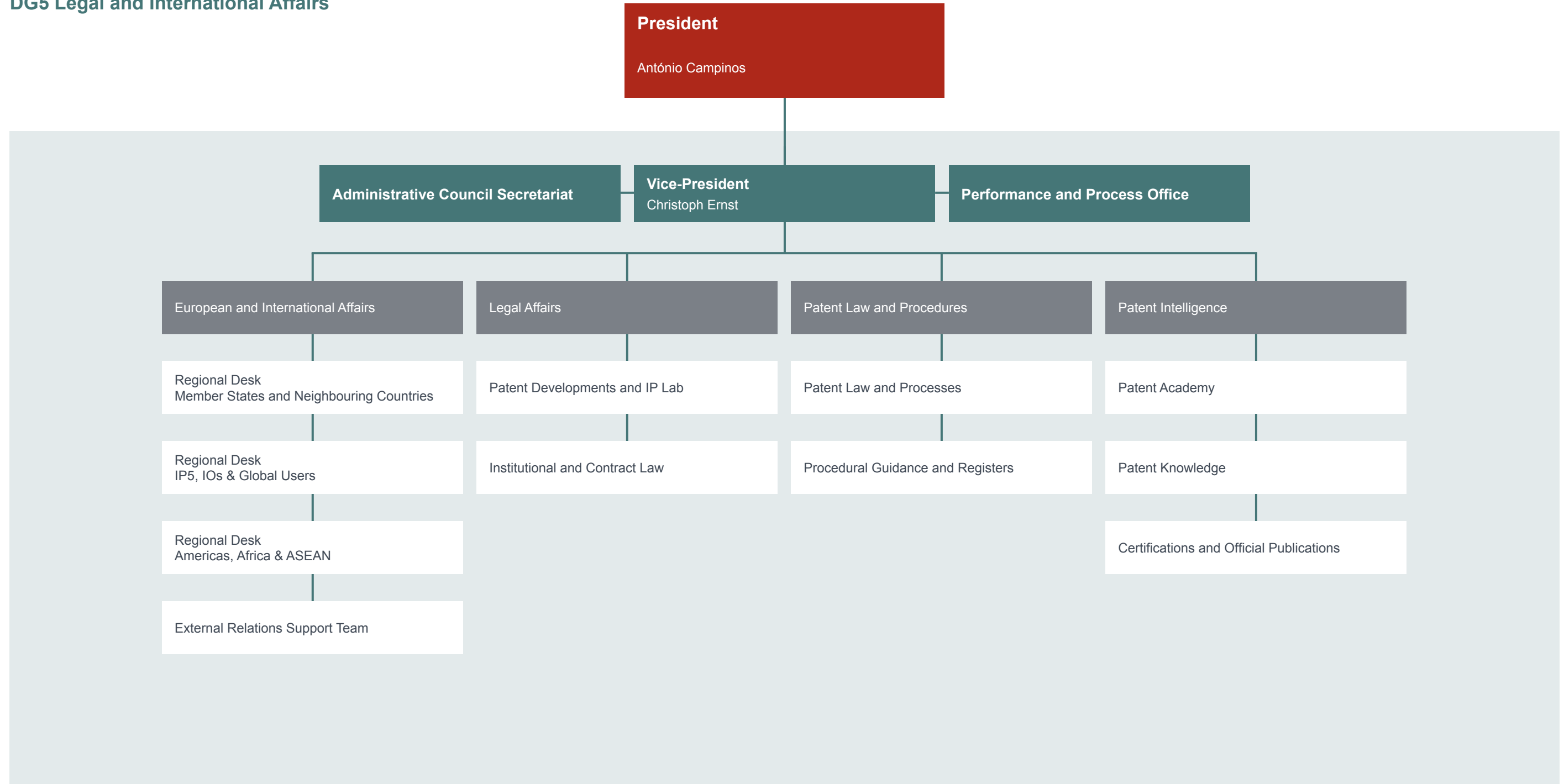
